The tuition fees shown above include VAT, applied at the standard rate of 20%. We remain committed to providing a high-quality, well-rounded education, and our fees are reviewed annually to ensure we continue to offer excellent opportunities and value for our pupils.

### Registration Fees (non-refundable)

- £150 (incl. VAT) per child

### Acceptance Deposits

- £500 Reception to Year 6
- £1000 Years 7 to 13

The offer of a place is secured by a completed registration form, along with the associated fee. Once the place has been accepted, the deposit must be paid. The acceptance deposit is non-refundable if the school place is not taken. It is retained until the pupil has left the School.



## Payment of Fees:

### Payment Options

- Payment in full on the first day of the term by Direct Debit
- Pay in 3 x instalments across each term by Direct Debit
- Payment in 12 monthly instalments via the School Fee Plan with Premium Credit (subject to status, terms and conditions)

No alternative payment terms are accepted unless agreed in advance with the Director of Finance and Resources.

### Notice

Withdrawal from the School requires full-terms notice; failure to provide such notice obliges payment of the full-term's fees. Notice must be given before the end of the preceding term. The same notice requirement applies to music tuition, learning support and transport services.

### Sibling Discount

For families with three or more siblings attending the School, a 10% termly discount will be applied to the basic tuition fees for the third child and any subsequent children.

### Discounts for Fees Paid in Advance

A discount is available if you choose to pay for a year or more years' fees in advance. The discount depends upon the length of advance payment. ### Deferred Entry

An additional holding deposit of £2,000 is necessary to secure a deferred entry, reimbursed on the first term's invoice.

### Childcare Vouchers

Childcare vouchers can be used as payment towards wrap-around care sessions, holiday clubs and UK residential trips at Ofsted settings until the 1st of September following their 15<sup>th</sup> birthday.

## Examinations

Public examination fees are recharged to parents.

## Stationery

In the Senior School, certain personal books are purchased by parents and retained by pupils for ongoing study. Mathematics textbooks are bought so pupils can keep a complete set for reference throughout their time at the School, alongside some specialist texts for public examination courses.

## Music Lessons

Music lessons for the Prep and Senior Schools are arranged directly with the Music Administrator. Lessons are delivered by visiting peripatetic teachers who will invoice parents directly. Some instruments are available to hire.
