



## Sixth Form Dress Code

The Sixth Form dress code guidelines follow the **gender-neutral** uniform policy now implemented in the Senior school.

The Sixth Form dress code is **smart business dress**.

**Should there be any query regarding what is acceptable, students should check with the Head of Sixth Form.**

<b>Suit</b>	<p>All students are required to wear either a smart suit with shirt and tie, a skirt suit, dress suit or a trouser suit. Dresses or skirts must be of an appropriate length. Short stretchy skirts are not acceptable.</p> <p>Jackets are compulsory and must be worn.</p>
<b>Shirt/Top</b>	<p>An appropriately styled shirt or top. No cropped or overly casual tops.</p>
<b>Jumper</b>	<p>These must be dark in colour, round or v neck and must be wearable under a Jacket.</p>
<b>Tights</b>	<p>Must be dark or neutral.</p>
<b>Shoes</b>	<p>Style of own choice but with 'sensible heels' (No trainers or plimsoles). School buildings and grounds are not suitable for high heels.</p>
<b>Outer Coat/Jacket</b>	<p>Smart</p>
<b>Games</b>	<p>Students are expected to wear Lingfield Sports Kit for both Tuesday afternoon games and fixtures.</p> <p>For 'off-site' activities in games, guidance will be given.</p>
<b>Jewellery and Hair</b>	<p>Jewellery should be discreet and appropriate for a business environment.</p> <p>Hair should be neat and tidy.</p> <p>Clean shaven.</p> <p>Earrings: single stud in each earlobe.</p> <p>No body piercings or tattoos should be visible.</p>
