- ◇ Please apply in writing by email or letter to the Prep School Office, stating that you would like your child to take part in the assessment morning. All applications **MUST** be received by **Friday 26th March 2021**. **No late applications will be accepted.**
- ◇ Under no circumstances will the examination date or time be changed to accommodate individual pupil/parent requests.
- ◇ The announcement of the successful candidates will be posted on **Friday 21st May 2021**.
- ◇ Academic Scholarships will last until the end of Year 8. If a pupil leaves the School before that point, the money saved on the Scholarship may be repayable (at the discretion of the Headmaster).
- ◇ Pupils who have been awarded Academic Scholarships will be expected to maintain a high level of achievement and effort, to participate in extra-curricular clubs and to make a positive contribution to school life. Failure to meet these criteria may result in the Scholarship being withdrawn at the discretion of the Headmaster.
- ◇ Academic Scholarships will be awarded solely on merit and performance 'on the day'.
- ◇ The Headmaster's decision is final.
- ◇ As the pupils are all internal candidates, if you would like to receive individual feedback on the scholarship assessments, please contact James Walton for an appointment.
- ◇ Please retain this document safely for future reference.

# Scholarship Programme 2021/22

Dear Parents and Students

Thank you for your interest in the Lingfield College Prep Scholarship Programme.

Academic Scholarships are awarded to students who demonstrate all-round academic ability. Scholars are expected to make a significant contribution to the life of the School. They create excellent role models for their peers and become important ambassadors for the School. Scholars receive an outstanding level of mentoring and are welcomed into the exclusive Scholars' Programme which helps them to develop skills in multiple intelligences; challenging them in the areas in which they feel confident, and supporting and extending them in the areas in which they feel less skilled. All of the activities on the programme are designed to excite and help each individual reach the very peak of their potential at School and beyond.

Each year the School offers up to three Academic Scholarships and two Headmaster's Awards, at the Headmaster's discretion, to high achieving pupils currently in Year 3. Academic Scholarships will be offered at a 10% discount of the full fees, with Headmaster's Awards being the equivalent of a 5% discount. Scholars also exclusively qualify to apply for a Lingfield Prep School Bursary, which is means-tested, if they so wish.

Year 3 Scholarships last until the end of Year 8, however, if pupils wish to be considered for a Senior School Academic Scholarship, which are offered at up to a 20% discount of fees, and last from Year 7 until Year 13, they can apply for one during Year 6. The Senior School Academic Scholarship, if awarded, would then replace the Year 3 Scholarship.

We welcome applications from all students, but I would ask you to consider suitability before applying as the application process and programme can be daunting and tiring for some students. If you have any questions or concerns about suitability, the ideal consultant would be your child's current class teacher.

I wish all applicants the very best of luck with their applications and look forward to watching the children excel!

# Academic Scholarships

Academic Scholars and Award Holders are expected to play a central role in the intellectual life of Lingfield Prep School. They will be seen as role models by the other pupils, and will exemplify this through their positive attitude to their academic studies. Scholars and Award Holders will be expected to participate in the Scholars' Programme. This is delivered through five workshops a year over a three year programme. Scholars' workshops will run during the school day. Inspired by the work of Sternberg and Gardner on multiple intelligences, the pupils will be challenged to complete workshops designed to help them to develop their analytic, creative and practical intelligences throughout the programme. They will also be supported to develop their emotional intelligence and resilience so that they become better equipped to deal with the challenges which they will face in their lives. Recent Scholars' workshops have covered varied topics including bilingualism, evidence based medicine and ancient philosophy.

Scholars and Award Holders are expected to excel academically and be active learners with a thirst for knowledge.

Pupils in Year 3 who apply for an Academic Scholarship will undertake a number of written tests and practical activities on the morning of **Saturday 15th May 2021**. These will include:

- English comprehension (25 minutes)
- Extended writing (20 minutes)
- Mathematics (25 minutes)
- Puzzles and problem solving activities (25 minutes)

Candidates should arrive at the Prep School Assembly Hall for registration at 9.15am and should be collected at 11.30am. School uniform should not be worn. All equipment and refreshments will be provided although candidates may bring a water bottle if they wish.
